In 1937 our hotel was built on the bank of Juutua River - close to legendary Lake Inari – originally for foreign fly fishermen. Still in the rapids outside the hotel, fishermen catch red trout up to 7 kilos of weight!

Our Traditional Hotel offers 29 double rooms, all renovated in 2004. We enthuse a cosy traditional style with hand woven rugs, and the sound of the rapids will lull you to sleep. We also have an original riverfront sauna and a classy restaurant.

Our new River Hotel has 16 double rooms, decorated with quality materials. Each room has own sauna, a drying cupboard, digital tv, broadband, fridge and kettle. Windows face River Juutua and you can enjoy the surrounding nature from your own balcony or patio. One of the rooms is equipped for disabled and therefore without a sauna. Our main building and its services are two minutes walk away.

Our Restaurant is famed for quality dishes made from pure ingredients that are provided by local fishermen and reindeer herders. Shellfish from close by Arctic Ocean, local mushrooms and berries are also used. We have received the **Good Food from Finland** -award in 2005.

Our location gives our guests the perfect chance to enjoy our unique natural environment as well as **genuine Sámi culture programmes** available in Inari village. Inari is the home for all important Sámi organisations, most importantly SIIDA, our fantastic Sámi museum and nature centre. Its beautiful exhibitions, interesting events and up to date meeting facilities provide a good service for our visitors. Inari village is the home also for top quality artisan shops and professional safari companies providing programmes for all seasons.



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
